



Dear friends and family,

Greetings from Kevin, Claudia and Danielle Miller. A lot has happened since the last time we've written. We moved into our new building, had our Thanksgiving dinner, had a kids day celebration, had our first kids camp, Claudia spent some time in the hospital and Danielle started 5th grade.

In October here in Brazil we celebrate kids day and every year with the church we do an outreach/celebration with the kids. This was the last event we did in our old building and it was a great way to finish the time that God blessed us there. We had 12 kids come out and Claudia put on a skit, we had music, did activities, played games, ate a lot and most of all shared about God's amazing love for us.

In November we moved into our new building which is much bigger and with the ability to do much more there. We were able to put in air conditioning in all the rooms. We have a kids ministry room, infants room, office and a temporary sanctuary. There is a garage area that is mostly enclosed that can fit 10 cars. Plans are to completely enclose the garage and turn it into a sanctuary that can fit about 100 people. There is also a big area in the back that we want to enclose that can function as a bigger room for the kids. In this facility we can also house teams that want to come and help.

We didn't celebrate Thanksgiving on the last Thursday of the month but on Friday as it is not a holiday here in Brazil and people need to work. This was the second Thanksgiving celebration we have done with the church here in Manaus. We moved in on Monday and on Friday we were already giving the Lord thanks with the very first thing we did in the new building. We had about 40 people come out and I shared about what it means to be thankful. First thankful to the Lord for His love and salvation and to remind them to always give thanks to the Lord for all things and all situations.

Just before Christmas on the 20th of December Claudia drove her dad to the airport and when she got back she was complaining about her abdomen

being really bloated and with a lot of pain. I took her to the hospital and we discovered that she had a hematoma on the inside of her pelvis. Actually they ran a lot of exams for days before they discovered what it was. As you may know, Claudia takes blood thinners, because back in 2002-2003 she had two strokes while we were planting the church in São Paulo and now has to take this medication to help prevent any further problems. But helping with one problem can cause other problems. With your blood so thin you can bruise much easier which happened internally with her. Shortly after New Year's she was released from the hospital. As I said before we need to give thanks for all things and all situations and we did give thanks for this. God blessed her with the medical plan that she has and we were blessed to see God use this situation to bring the people in the church closer. Danielle stayed with a family in the church for most of the time and was loved and well taken care of and Claudia is doing great now.

On January 20th we took the kids from the church on our very first kids camp. We took a boat ride over to a ranch where we pitched some tents, played some games, had Bible studies, made activities, roasted marshmallows and swam. We spent two days there and the kids definitely did not want to leave. We had two Bible studies, one on Friday night and the other on Saturday morning. The kids really paid attention and asked a lot of questions. I could see that they were really understanding what God was wanting to speak

to them. Some of the adults that came were really blessed by some of the questions that were asked. Five of the kids prayed to ask God to come into their lives for the first time. We had a total of 13 kids that participated.

The church that has been receiving and taking care of the support for us closed the doors in mid-December. They had been a blessing for us for so many years and we are grateful to the Lord for them and their love for us. With that I have been talking with a few different churches to see if they can help us in this situation and not only take care of our support, but could also be a home church for us. Financial support is greatly needed, but it definitely isn't the most important, we need spiritual support (encouragement and prayer). I want to thank all of you that have been praying and financially supporting us and the ministry, we will let you know when we have a new place for you to send support.
